WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?

When you have made an appointment at one of the hubs you should receive a text reminder with the postcode of the appointment location to help you find the right place.

You can cancel the appointment by responding 'CANCEL' to the text or by calling your own practice who can cancel the appointment for you.

Please note that the hubs operate a similar policy to your registered practice and if you are more than 10 minutes late for your appointment you may not be seen.

Upon arrival, the doctors, nurses and healthcare assistants will ask for your consent in order to access your medical records. If you do not wish for your medical record to be viewed, we will not be able to see you in the Hub service.



WHAT THE HUBS 'WONT' DO

The Extended Hours Hub provides GP service for routine and urgent appointments only. You will NOT be offered an appointment at a Hub if:

- you need a routine review for a long terms condition
- You have an end of life care plan
- You are registered with the Safe Haven service
- You have serious mental health issues which requires continuity of care
- You are seeking assistance for substance or alcohol misuse
- You are requiring minor Surgery
- You want to get a private medical or a home visit
- You require a fit note or other medical certificate
- *All non-core NHS letters (e.g. housing benefits)
- You need a travel health consultation
- You need a private or routine non-urgent NHS referrals (Recommended Referrals will be made to practice, referral must be appropriately signed off by patients registered GP.
